MEMORANDUM FOR NG J1 RRF (All-Entire RRF)

SUBJECT: SMOM 18-051, Flight Physicals for 15Q and 15W.

1. References:

a. Department of the Army Pamphlet 611-21, Military Occupational Classification and Structure, dated 22 January 2007.

b. HQ TRADOC Tasking Order, dated 07 March 2018.

2. Effective 4 June 2018, Soldiers will no longer be required to complete the Class IV Flight Physical prior to shipping to training. All Flight Physicals will be conducted at Fort Jackson after arriving at the Reception Battalion.

3. All Soldiers scheduled to ship prior to 4 Jun 18 must have a completed flight physical prior to ship date. Any Soldiers without a completed Flight Physical prior to 4 Jun 18 will not be authorized to ship and must renegotiate their contract.

4. All BCT for MOSs 15Q and 15W will be conducted at Fort Jackson. Soldiers currently in the Recruit Sustainment Program (RSP) will have their training path changed to reflect Fort Jackson for Basic Combat Training (BCT).

5. In the event that the Soldier fails the Flight Physical, he/she will be reclassified into another MOS and shipped to the appropriate AIT location.

6. If the Flight Physical has already been started but not complete or has not been started, do not continue or schedule the Flight Physical. The Soldier will complete the Flight Physical at Fort Jackson.

7. RSP will Inform all 15Q and 15W Soldiers currently in the RSP and are shipping on or after 4 Jun 18, that the BCT has changed to Fort Jackson.

8. Guidance Counselors will ensure that the travel order and transportation documents reflect the correct ship location for all Soldiers shipping to training to Fort Jackson for 15Q and 15W on or after 4 Jun 18.

9. Applicants enlisting into the MOSs of 15Q and 15W that do not pass the Flight Physical will be reclassified into another MOS.
